The Crypt School Prevent Statement

At The Crypt School we have taken the following steps to ensure that our students are protected from radicalisation:

- All staff have received PREVENT awareness training through the Gloucestershire Children Safeguarding Board
- The Prevent Duty is reflected within our Safeguarding policy and so is part of whole staff training to ensure we fulfil our statutory safeguarding commitments.
- British Values are promoted through the Assembly programme and other elements of Personal Social Health and Citizenship Education (PSHCE) alongside the School's Values
- Appropriate risk assessments are carried out by the Safeguarding Team
- Safer internet use forms part of the Computing curriculum, PSHCE and Sex and Relationships Education
- Tolerance for different religions is taught through the Ethics and Philosophy curriculum
- Management of IT system involves filtering of key words and blocking of site
